1	Contractor - hire (Hr)	Hour (Hr)	Contractor hire rate including equipment. Record materials separately if supplied by party other than contractor.
2	Equipment - hire (Hr)	Hour (Hr)	Any equipment hired and used to enable project to be undertaken. Could be part of applicant contribution or funded component.
3	Fencing - electric (m)	Metre (m)	Stock proof fence with at least three wires – a minimum of 2 to be live.
4	Fencing - rabbit proof fence (m)	Metre (m)	Permanent fence constructed with rabbit proof wire.
5	Fencing - standard (m)	Metre (m)	Stock proof permanent fence. Add fence description.
6	Investigations - data collection (No).	Number (No).	Investigations refer one off surveys; - Establishment of sites or field trials for research and development purposes. - Cultural heritage survey, bird survey project area/site, salinity surveys - Ground truthing, mapping
7	Labour (reflects In-kind Landholder Labour (Hr)).	Hour (Hr)	Landholder/applicants in-kind contribution in hours. Landholder in-kind contribution appears to be guided by fund source; (\$30/hr)
8	Pest animal control (Hrs & Ha)	Hour (Hr) & Hectares (Ha)	All activities focused on controlling pest animals (fox, hare, rabbit) by shooting, baiting, removal of harbour and warren destruction. Include area treated/protected
9	Pest plant control - weed removal (Ha)	Hectare (Ha)	Any weed removal - weed control, mechanical and chemical.
10	Plan Development - select as appropriate (No).	Number (No).	Includes: Development of overall group/regional plans. Includes EBMP and Property Management Plans (including EMS)
11	Project Management (No.)	(No.)	Project Management is the activity used to record; Salary all capacity building and educational activities, field days, workshops etc.
12	Project Management- monitoring & evaluation (No).	Number (No).	Monitoring & Evaluation includes site monitoring against a known baseline, establishment of benchmarking data or project or program evaluation activities. E.g. 1000 tube stock on 1/7/05 and on 1/1/06 500 tube stock are alive (~50% survival)
13	Vegetation - covenant established (Ha).	Hectare (Ha)	For example, Trust for Nature Covenants, Section 173 etc
14	Vegetation - farm forestry (Ha)	Hectare (Ha)	Includes, Plantations, Agro forestry and Carbon Tender.
15	Vegetation - planting perennial grass pasture (Ha.)	Hectare (Ha)	Area in hectares of vegetation planted to perennial pasture in salt affected areas. Species and quantities of species should be noted.
16	Vegetation - planting native species (Ha)	Hectare (Ha)	Area in hectares of vegetation planted.
17	Vegetation - purchase seed (Kg)	Kilogram (Kg)	Cost of local native seed mix per Kg to be direct seeded. Species list with quantities to be attached.
18	Vegetation - purchase tree guards (No).	Number (No).	Includes stakes
19	Vegetation - purchase tubestock (No).	Number (No).	Appropriate mix of tubestock species. Species and quantities of species should be uploaded as an efile in Works Project.
20	Vegetation – site preparation chemicals (ha)	Hectares(ha)	This includes chemicals applied either through a knap sack or as a spot spray. This should also take into account number of spot sprays.
